

Erasmus Mundus Master of Science in Ecohydrology



DECLARATION

I declare that, **Shawkat Sohel**, Bangladeshi, was selected as a student for the Erasmus Mundus Master of Science in Ecohydrology (**Ecohyd**) to start the academic year 2010/2011. First year host institution will be the **University of Lodz (Poland)**. The student will receive an Erasmus Mundus scholarship program totalling 48,000 € (forty-eight thousand euros), intended to cover the costs of tuition, travel and subsistence during the 24 month duration of the course.

The **Ecohyd** is an international master program coordinated by the University of Algarve, Portugal, in cooperation with the University of Lodz (Poland), with the National University of La Plata (Argentina), with Christian - Albrechts University zu Kiel (Germany), and with the UNESCO-IHE Delft (the Netherlands).

The course will start on September 20, 2010 and end on September 30, 2012. Beyond this period is considered the possibility of an additional six months for completion and defence of the thesis dissertation, which can be performed in any of the partner institutions of higher education mentioned above. Taking this into account, the entry visa and residence in Europe should be issued for a maximum period of 30 months and must also have an entry visa to return to Argentina and Europe, as the result of a mandatory mobility of the master's program.

Accommodation will be provided from September 1, 2010.
